It has appeared preferable to produce in this volume three rolls in extenso, rather than to attempt judicious extracts from a number of rolls. From a legal point of view specimen cases would be superfluous; and it would require an arbitrary editor to decide whether Robert of Easby had a greater claim to appear in print than Hugh of Baildon, or whether Preston was a more important vill than Coneysthorpe. There is, indeed, a tedious monotony in the ordinary forms of action; but these rolls are of distinct value in showing in what degree certain legal principles, and more particularly the principle of trial by jury, had become part of English law as ordinarily administered by the King s justices in the thirteenth century; and extracts, are sometimes apt to display the exception to the rule.
